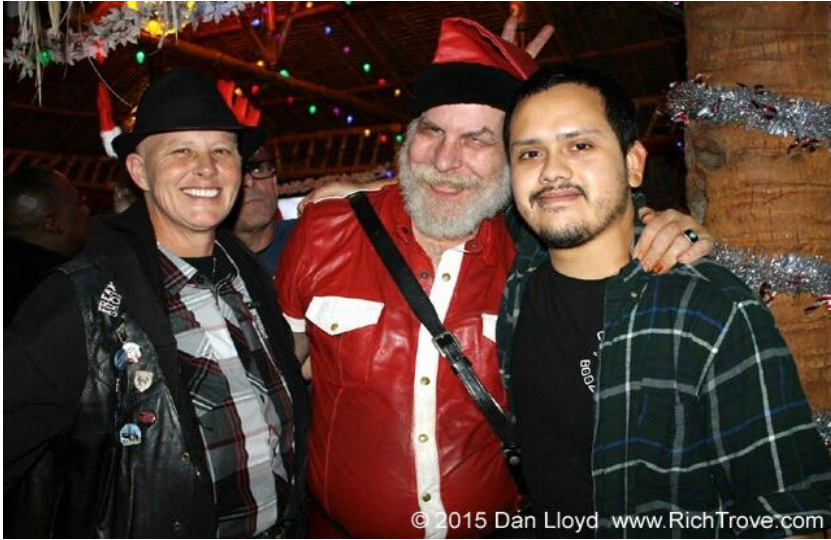

CHARLOTTE MAXWELL CLINIC
INTEGRATIVE CANCER CARE

The Charlotte Maxwell Clinic (“CMC”) provides free integrative care for individuals fighting serious cancers. The main focus is to provide quality care for low income and destitute women in the greater Bay Area. From CMC’s website:

“Low-income women are often diagnosed in later stages of cancer when the survival rates drop dramatically. Our clients range from the homeless to the working poor, and their numbers are growing at a rate of 50% per year.”

In addition to standard medical approaches, CMC offers acupuncture, herbs, homeopathy, bodywork, guided imagery, movement and nutritional therapies. CMC also has a special In-Home Comfort Care program, which provides in-home treatments for those clients with end-stage cancer who are too weak to come to our clinic. CMC has spent 25 incredible years providing integrative cancer care and supportive services for Bay Area underserved women living with cancer.

CMC provides integrated medical services to over 800 clients, primarily in Alameda, Contra Costa, Solano, San Francisco, Marin and San Mateo counties, through a volunteer base of over 400 healthcare practitioners. CMC is a California licensed free public health clinic and 501(c)(3) non-profit organization.
