

Pledge Requirements

Once you've completed the ACLC membership application you must complete the pledge process. This process is designed to help you become familiar with ACLC and its membership.

You'll be assigned a Leather Buddy. Your Leather Buddy will be responsible for keeping you informed about various ACLC meetings and activities and should be a valuable resource during the pledge process:

1. You must attend no less than 3 General Assembly meetings within a 4-month period.
2. You must assist at one ACLC event/function. You can assist in any number of ways, such as:
 - a. Selling raffle tickets with a member
 - b. Setup/cleanup crew
 - c. Taking photos
 - d. Booth staff

Complete these simple requirements within 120 days of submitting your completed application to the Board, and your application will be voted upon by the membership.

Once voted in, you will be eligible to take and sign the Membership Pledge and receive your membership pin. At that time, you will also be required to pay your annual membership dues.

ACLC reserves the right to refuse membership to anyone.
