



#### **EDUCATION:** Foot Worship by Mistress Nyna

My first acknowledgment is to Midori, she is an expert on this subject and is published on the topic.

My third acknowledgement is always start at the beginning and communicate, negotiate and obtain consent.

The basics are similar to other forms of erotic play. Discuss in advance any limits, medical conditions and expectations or desires that require attention and aftercare. Does this sound like too much talk and not enough action? Well, there is a lot to communicate in regards to foot pleasure. Is it humiliating? Dirty? Is it non sexual service? Is it a visual arousal or is it a chance for objectification? Explore the fantasies and be clear on the safe word, if a sensation or emotional limit is reached. Is this one aspect of a larger and longer play scene that evolves into more body parts or other fantasies? Think about your pleasure and the pleasure you will provide to some one else. What does it look like, feel like, taste like and bring to the surface of your being?

As a dominant I enjoy the visual of surrender and presentation at my feet from another person. I enjoy a special act of service given to soak my feet, receive a foot massage and a tender erotic worship with kissing, licking sucking and more...I enjoy the control and power exchange that come with allowing erotic touch of my body under my direction. Sometimes a job well done comes with rewards such as a peek up a skirt or application of a shoe heel in special spots for some additional shoe play. But enough about me, explore your own fantasies! Explore your feelings about your feet and what freaks you out, then play with your desires and communicate those wishes to another player of your choice.

Read some online education on the topic of feet fetish, foot care, foot massage, tickling, or purchase a book by Midori or other authors on the subject. Just remember the basics of any scene and have fun!
